

Advent Wreath Craft

This fun and simple craft is a great way to help your younger children better understanding the true meaning of Christmas

Materials:

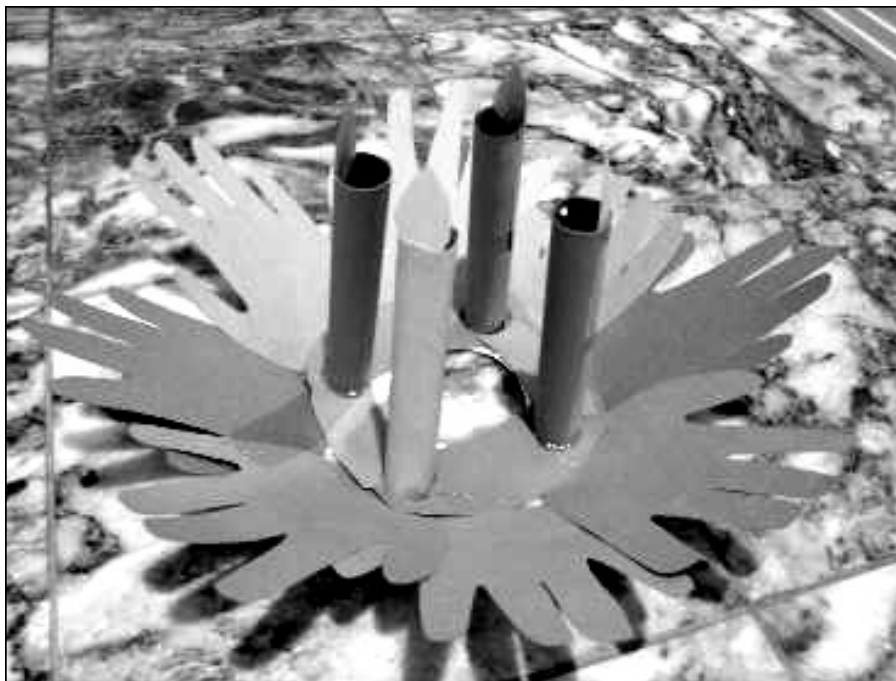
Green, Purple, Pink and Yellow Construction Paper

1 paper plate

Glue and Scissors

Pen/Pencil

1. Have your children trace their hands about 10 times on green construction paper. Use scissors to cut out the hands (trace your hands as well so every family member has a "hand in" this project).
2. Cut a circle out of the center of the paper plate
3. Glue the cut out hands around the paper plate, fingers facing out.
4. Cut 3 strips of purple construction paper and 1 strip of pink construction paper, approximately 6 inches long by 5 inches wide.
5. Roll the strips of paper and glue the ends together to make the candles. Glue the candles to the base of the wreath.
6. Cut out flames from the yellow construction paper and glue onto each candle as your family celebrates advent!
